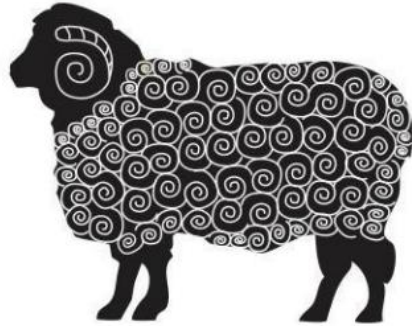

Welcome

The Fleece Inn is an imposing three-storey Victorian pub with stone-flagged floors, cosy little rooms & real fires, set on the famous Main Street in the picturesque village of Haworth with 10 en-suite letting rooms over the 1st & 2nd floors, food is served all day, from breakfast right through to dinner, our food is freshly cooked to order with many ingredients locally sourced.

The building is located on the cobbled & sloping Main Street.

There is a wide outward opening internal door which easily allows access for a wheelchair. In the main bar area there is a variety of seating both fixed & loose that is easily adjusted. Limited parking is available on the street.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to The Fleece Inn by bus and train.
 - At the bottom of the hill outside the pub The bus stop is 0.1 miles / 0.2 km from The Fleece Inn.
 - The nearest train station is Keighley . The train station is 5 miles / 8.1 km from The Fleece Inn.
 - there is also a Steam Train service that operates from Keighley to Haworth on weekends, special events & school holidays
(Keighley and Worth Valley Railway)
- Buses run regularly to within 100 metres of the Main Street

Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with Bronte Taxis by calling 01535 644442. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

Parking

- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.
- we have parking permits available for a nearby car park but none available directly at the pub due to residential restrictions

Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is sloped.

Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.

Getting around inside

Visual Impairment - General Information

- Some parts of the venue have low lighting.

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, wall lights, floor standing lights, bedside lamps, desk or table lamps, spot lights and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED, energy saving and traditional filament. Some lights can be controlled independently.
- TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- Some bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- We have wi-fi free bedrooms, for visitors with electro-sensitivity.
- we can give details of cleaning products on request. We have a dog-friendly room that pets do stay in. All of our bedding is non-allergic
- We can move the bedroom furniture, to improve accessibility.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 15 steps.
- All bedrooms are ensuite.
- We have bathrooms with a bath and overhead shower. The shower has a handrail.

Bar

The Fleece Inn

- From the main entrance to the bar, there is level access.

Public toilet

Fleece Inn toilets

- There is a public toilet for disabled visitors.
- You need a RADAR key to open the public toilet.

- From the main entrance to the public toilet, there is level access. The toilets have handrails.

Place to eat and drink

The Fleece Inn

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access. To get to a table, there are no steps.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- We cater for vegetarian, gluten free (celiacs), lactose free (dairy free), nut free and vegan specific diets.

Getting around outside

Smoking

front of The Fleece Inn

- From the main entrance to the smoking area, there is level access.
- The accessible smoking area is on benches located at the front of the building on the Main Street

Terrace

terraced beer garden

- To get to a table, there are 50 steps.
- the beer garden is on the second floor of the building on a level with the roof line up over 4 flights of stairs

Emergency evacuation procedures

- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.
